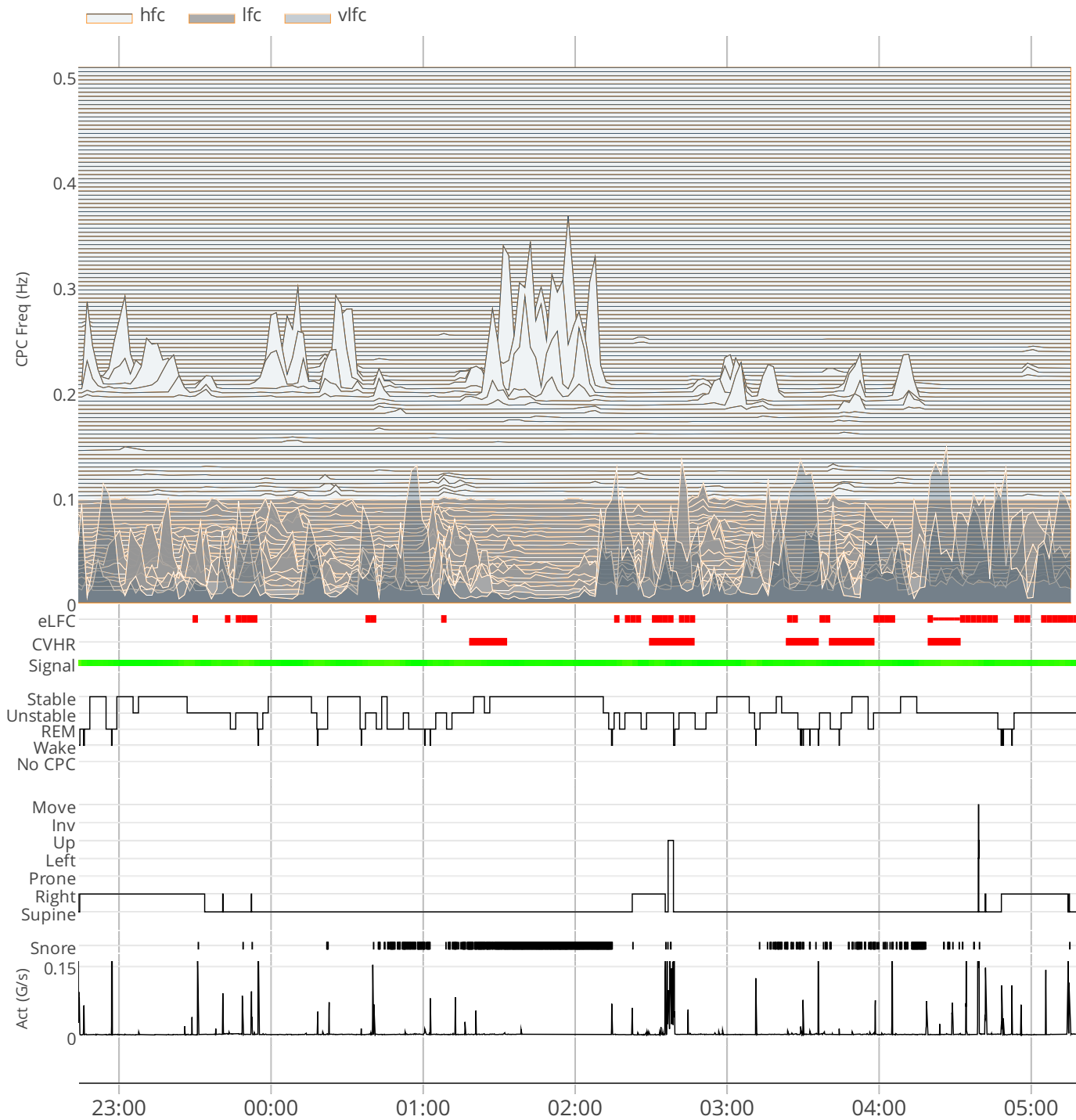

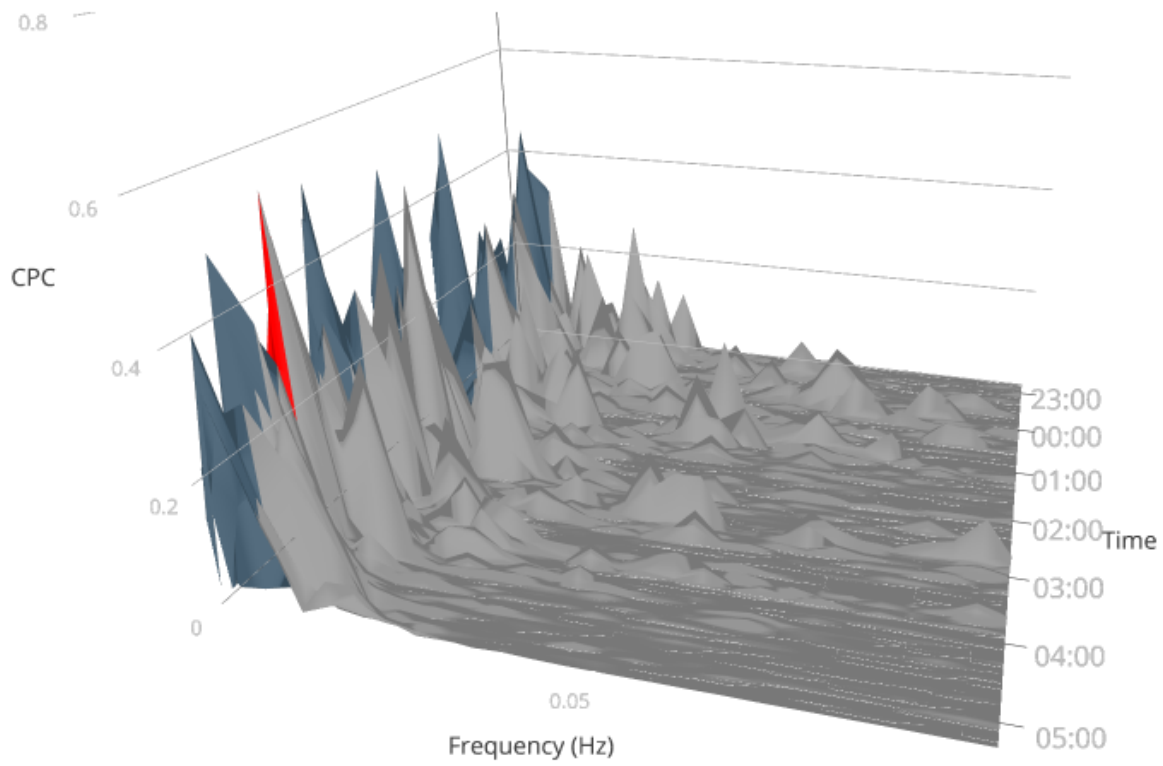
Spectrogram Front View:
